





### Trend of ROE




### Trend of DE Ratio




### Trend of Divident Payout Ratio




### Trend of Average Collection Period




### Indian Paper Industry - Trends in Net Income to Total Assets




## Indian Paper Industry - Trends in CURRENT RATIO




## INDIAN PAPER INDUSTRY - QUICK RATIO




## Income Statement: Common Size Analysis




## Balance Sheet - Assets: Common Size Analysis



## Balance Sheet - Liabilities: Common Size Analysis








